

## PETRUS JACOBUS JOUBERT (1834-1900)



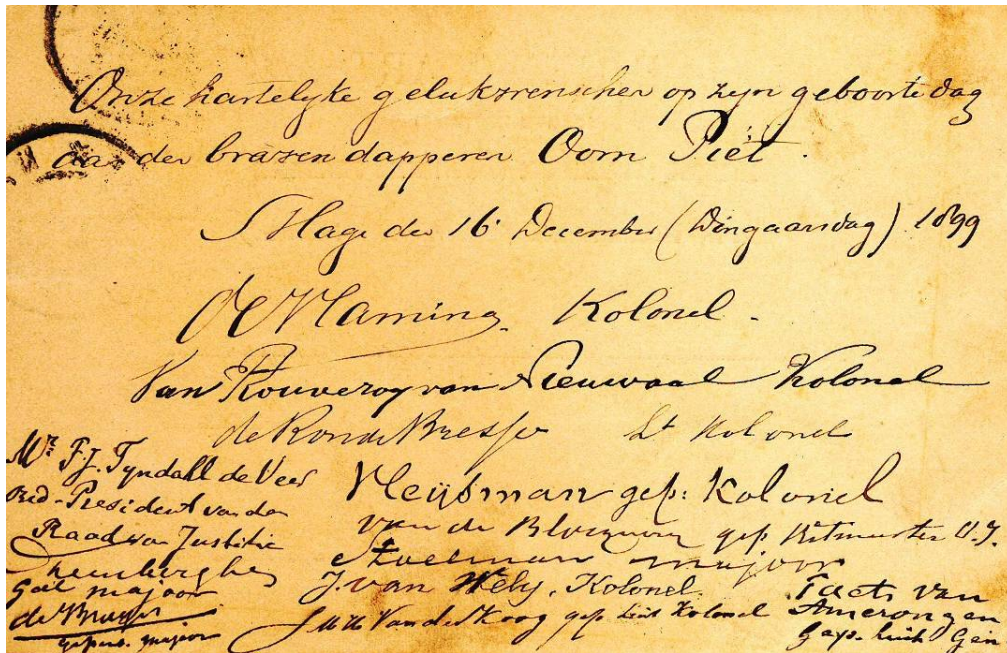
Petrus Jacobus Joubert ("Oom Piet") was born in Oudtshoorn, Cape Colony on 20 January 1834. He died in Pretoria on 28 March 1900<sup>1</sup>. He was Commandant-General of the South African Republic from 1880 to 1900. The post-card arrived 5 days after his 66<sup>th</sup> birthday and two months before he died suddenly of peritonitis.
